

**Pastor Corder Note**

I have been thinking about this statement a lot lately, Jesus told his disciples to pray to Our FATHER. Matthew 6: 9 **“This, then, is how you should pray: “Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name, 10 your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. 11 Give us today our daily bread. 12 And forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors. 13 And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one.’**

14 For if you forgive other people when they sin against you, your heavenly Father will also forgive you. 15 But if you do not forgive others their sins, your Father will not forgive your sins.

We are not talking about all our different dad’s but praying, praising, and petitioning the same father that Jesus did. That which unites us is Jesus, we were once not a people but now we are the people of God, in Christ, only in Christ. Our lives are hidden in Christ, in his completed work on the cross. Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name, Jesus’ father is different from all others, He is not from here, and his Name/ character is to be considered separate and above all others. It is to be set apart in that, we don’t use it in ordinary conversation, certainly not in a curse, and not even in vain, futile or useless ways.

When we come to realize who Jesus is and the mission that Father sent him on, we come to join them on their mission abandoning all other courses, mission or work to bring about their kingdom, rule and government and domain.

We come to recognize, our dependence upon Father and it is now to him we go for our needs to be met and trust that He as a higher loving Father that has endless means will met our needs and in a way that we should see a greater purpose in then just getting but in giving. Give us this day our daily bread, what Father gave Jesus, he gives us in Christ, what he gives us he gives it for us, not just me. Often when God give one a loaf of Bread, they are to pinch off some and pass it on.

This next section is supper, we ask our Father to forgive, as we also forgive. I am so pleased that he initiated and showed us the example of this in Christ, but I am also so pleased that he expects this of us. We have to look at one who has become indebted to us in one manner or another and we are to forgive them as modeled and all the while acknowledging that we have the same father. One Spirit who convicts men of sin, convinces of righteousness and of judgment to come.

John 14:23 Jesus replied, “Anyone who loves me will obey my teaching. My Father will love them, and we will come to them and make our home with them.

When we love Jesus we are together with God and with one another.

### Kingdom Work Youth Ministry

Happy November Beloved,

Have you ever heard of the Doctrines of Grace? I encourage us to ponder these for a moment and let it humble us before our Sovereign Father God.

Here are the 5 doctrines of Grace that outline how a person is saved. I believe these 5 words- radical depravity, sovereign election, definite atonement, irresistible call, and preserving grace - supremely display the sovereign grace of God.

Radical Depravity is found simply in Ephesians 2:1, **“And you were dead in the trespasses and sins...”** This of course affects every area of life. Sovereign Election is all about God’s will and way. God is creator God and does as He please.

The Bible teaches us that it is God who chooses and God who saves since we are unable to do so if we are depraved. Romans 8:29-30, **“For those whom he foreknew he also predestined to be conformed to the image of his Son, in order that he might be the firstborn among many brothers. 30 And those whom he predestined he also called, and those whom he called he also justified, and those whom he justified he also glorified.”**

Definite Atonement means this election and grace is for certain people, a chosen people. And those who God chose before the beginning of time will in fact believe in the gospel and be saved. John 6:37 says, **“All that the Father gives me will come to me, and whoever comes to me I will never cast out.”**

Irresistible call basically means those who God chooses will indeed believe in him because God gives them grace, not because of anything men can do. Ezekiel 36:26 states that God is the one who initiates and completes a believer's call, **“And I will give you a new heart, and a new spirit I will put within you. And I will remove the heart of stone from your flesh and give you a heart of flesh.”**

Preserving Grace is basically eternal security, meaning, whomever God elects and calls will indeed stay the course because God is the one who holds them. There is no falling away from true saving grace. John 10:28-30, **“I give them eternal life, and they will never perish, and no one will snatch them out of my hand. My Father, who has given them to me, is greater than all, and no one is able to snatch them out of the Father’s hand. 30 I and the Father are one.”**

Give Glory to God for his unending love and grace for His people.
